2) GOLDEN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY MASS, NOW SEPTEMBER 27

The annual June celebration of 50^{th} Wedding Anniversary Mass with Bishop Johnston at the Cathedral has been rescheduled for Sunday, September 27, due to the coronavirus and a concern for everyone's ongoing safety and health.

3) The Catholic Key has suspended publication for the time being and information and articles will be available on social media and the diocesan website at kcsjcatholic.org. A number of factors contributed to this decision, such as parishioners being unable to receive issues at their parish churches where there is no public Mass, the increased circulation costs occasioned by the COVID-19 virus, and the desire to minimize the number of individuals at the chancery offices.

2) PARISH CHURCH DEDICATION ANNIVERSARIES

This month the following parishes celebrate the solemnity of the anniversary of the dedication of their churches: St. Francis Xavier, Kansas City (July 4); Sacred Heart, Kansas City (July 12, replacing the 25^{th} Sunday in Ordinary Time this year); St. Sabina, Belton (July 12 replacing the 25^{th} Sunday in Ordinary Time this year); and St. Bartholomew Windsor

(July 19, replacing the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time this year).

3) PASCHAL CANDLE RECYCLING

6) DIOCESAN DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE BLESSING OF FARM ANIMALS, AUGUST 3

Our diocese observes an annual day of prayer for blessing farm animals this summer Abbot Benedict Neenan of Conception Abbey will preside for the diocesan celebration at St. Rose of Lima Parish in Savannah at 7:00 p.m. Owners of animals are invited to bring them for an outdoor blessing on the parish property. Other parishes and all households are encouraged to remember the animal farming community on this day. Although the blessing of these animals does not take place during Mass, a ritual may be found in the Book of Blessings, Chapter 25. Resources for homes and parishes will be available soon.

7) WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION, SEPTEMBER 1

In conjunction with Eastern Orthodox Churches, the Roman Catholic Church observes September 1 as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Parishes are encouraged to include prayers and songs for creation in the liturgy, and use the presidential prayers from the missal's Mass for the Sanctification of Human Labor from the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions (no. 26; see especially the second Collect of formulary A), as well as readings from Volume IV of the lectionary from the Mass "For the Blessing of Human Labor," nos. 907-911. The Office of Divine Worship especially recommends Genesis 2:4b-9, 15 and Psalm 90:2, 3-5a, 12-13, 14 and 16 (see nos. 907-2 and 909-1, respectively).

- Mandated Reporters: Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse
- ▶ VIRTUS® has automated the assignment of these modules for all brand new VIRTUS® users
- ► Contact Sherry Huffman at huffman@diocesekcsj.org if you have new employees or volunteers that already have VIRTUS® accounts but have not yet met the training requirement. The modules can be manually assigned by our office so training requirements can be fulfilled.
